Miss Brice Will Star in Production

Melton Also on List for New Attraction

The Beauty Box Theater is to close its imaginary doors February 22 to make way for a radio production of the Ziegfeld Follies, starring Fannie Brice, stage comedienne, and James Melton, air-lane tenor. The new production will be heard over Columbia and KHJ at 8 p.m. each Saturday—the same time Beauty Box Theater presentations have been released.

Today Melton becomes stellar vocalist on the "College Prom" series, featuring Red Nichols' orchestra and the Modern Choir. The program is leased over the WJZ-N.B.C. network and cannot be dialed locally on any long-wave station. Short-wave receivers bring it in over W8XK (11.87) at 5:30 p.m.
