Perry Como show, 7 p. m., channel 5—A generally amiable hour, as Perry kicks off with "Moonlight Love," using Walter Winchell as a sounding board. Kathryn Grayson stops by for a bit of close harmony with the star, and Paul Douglas re-creates the "recitation" scene from his new film, "The Solid Gold Cadillac." Not as much sparkle as usual in the "guest spots," but Perry's closing medley, including "You Were Meant For Me" and "Time On My Hands," is as listenable as ever.

Caesar's Hour, 8 p. m., channel 5—A tempest in a teapot for the commuters as Sid and Janet are faced with dividing four seats to a hit Broadway show among six people. It's a quick lesson on how to lose friends; most amusing when Howie Morris and Carl Reiner are at each other's throats. Janet Warbles "Ridin' High" between commercials, and the whole gang winds up satirizing one of your favorite TV stanzas. Typical shenanigans for Caesar fans.

George Gobel show, 9 p. m., channel 5—George's literate nonsense, appealing to the ear as well as the eye, has never been more welcome than now after a rash of witless new programs.
