IN THE TIMES, JAN. 19, 1890:
 In an editorial, The Times urged the City Council to lose no time in ordering the paving of a number of prominent streets.

PARIS — French newspapers published reports that Emperor Francis Joseph of Austria-Hungary was prepared to abdicate his throne.

SAN FRANCISCO—Gen. M. G. Vallejo died at his home at Sonoma aged 82. He was closely identified with critical episodes in the history of California and once was military governor.

THIRTY-FIVE YEARS AGO
IN THE TIMES, JAN. 19, 1915:
 City Atty. Stephens left for Sacramento, where he was to submit the city's legislative program to the Legislature. Chief on the list was a bill to make easier the sale of aqueduct bonds.

WARSAW — The Germans

occupied Kielce, a Russian military base west of Warsaw.

PARIS — Police ordered street lamps dimmed. Buildings would no longer allow light to escape. The orders were prompted by the fear of night aerial attack. Bad weather slowed down the fighting at the French front.

IN THE TIMES, JAN. 19, 1935:

Mayor Shaw turned the first shovel of earth in the \$500,000 improvement program for the Municipal Airport. The work would keep 1300 men busy three months.

Fifty Santa Monica Shriners were rescued from the barge Star of Scotland after being marooned by stormy weather.

NEW YORK — Mrs. Anna Roosevelt Dall, daughter of the President, was married to John Boettiger, former Washington correspondent for the Chicago Tribune. The ceremony was quietly conducted in this city, with General Sessions Judge Kernochan officiating.
