Georgia Tech Team

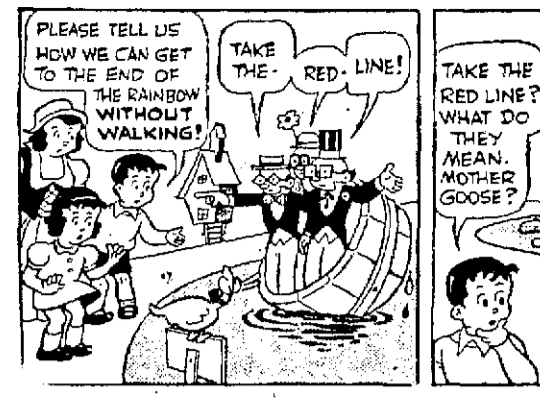
Leaves for West

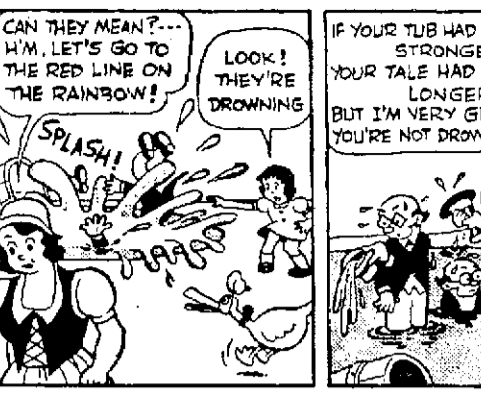
