

Jack Pearl And Lou Holtz Will Be Heard With Vallee

Constance Bennett Also Scheduled On Crooner's Hour; Late Dramatist Herne To Be Honored

Two of America's foremost dialect comedians will come together when Rudy Vallee presents Jack Pearl and, for the sixth consecutive time, Lou Holtz, on his WEAF program Thursday at 7 p. m.

Another guest on this program will be the lovely Constance Bennett, elder of the famed Bennett sisters and daughter of the veteran stage actor, Richard Bennett.

As a fitting tribute to the late, James A. Herne, famous Nineteenth Century dramatist, on the occasion of the 100th anniversary of his birth, the National Broadcasting Co. has selected his "The Minute Men of 1774" as the first production in its elaborate series of America's Lost Plays which will be presented over WEAF Thursdays from 8 to 9 p. m.

The playwright is the father of Julie and Chrystal Herne, both of whom are famous in the contemporary theatre. He is best remembered for "Shoe Acres" and "Sag Harbor," which were laid in his beloved New England. "The Minute Men," another of his most popular works was, until recently, believed irrevocably lost. It has just been unearthed after four years of research work by Earl H. Clark, executive director of the Dramatists' Play Service, who worked in cooperation with the Authors' League of America and the Dramatists' Guild and with the financial assistance of the Rockefeller Foundation.

COLDWATER DRUNKENNESS FIXED BY LAW

Legislators Say Driver Who Drinks Half Pint Is Intoxicated

INDIANAPOLIS, Ind., July 6 - (UP) - Any motorist who drinks a half-pint of whisky or its equivalent in beer or gin is intoxicated whether he thinks so or not, according to a new Indiana law.

The statute, passed by the recent session of the legislature and signed by the governor, defines drunkenness and sobriety in terms of the percentage of alcohol in the blood stream.

Between these two marks he has only to convince the police and the witnesses. The bleary-eyed driver who can't say "intoxicated" is as much on the spot as if he had drunk the law's half-pint.
