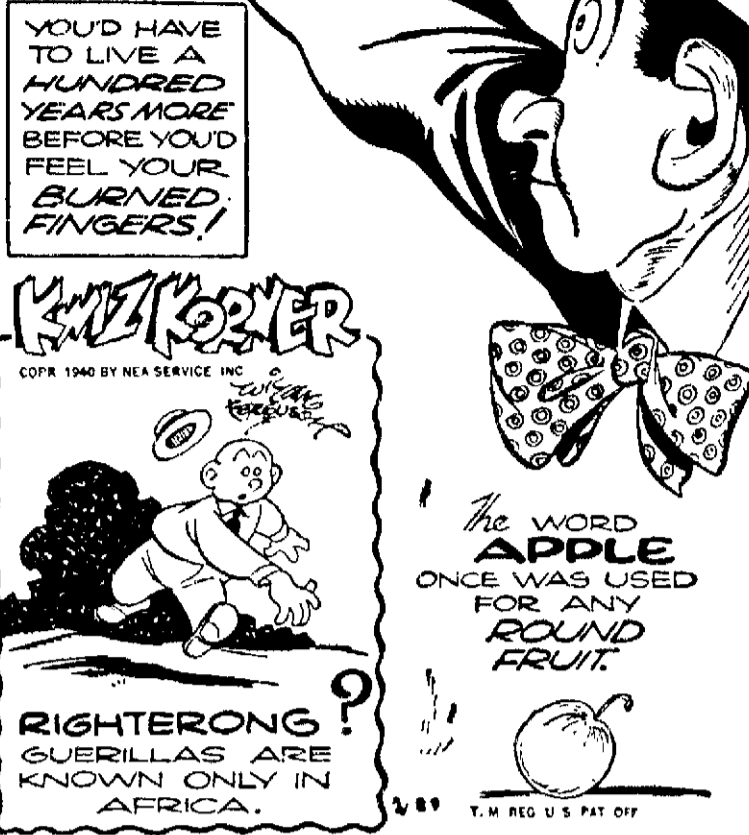

"A Chump At Oxford" Is Title Of New Laugh Riot; Power And Lamour Teamed In Quilna Attraction
