Stamp Albums Filled With Famous Churches

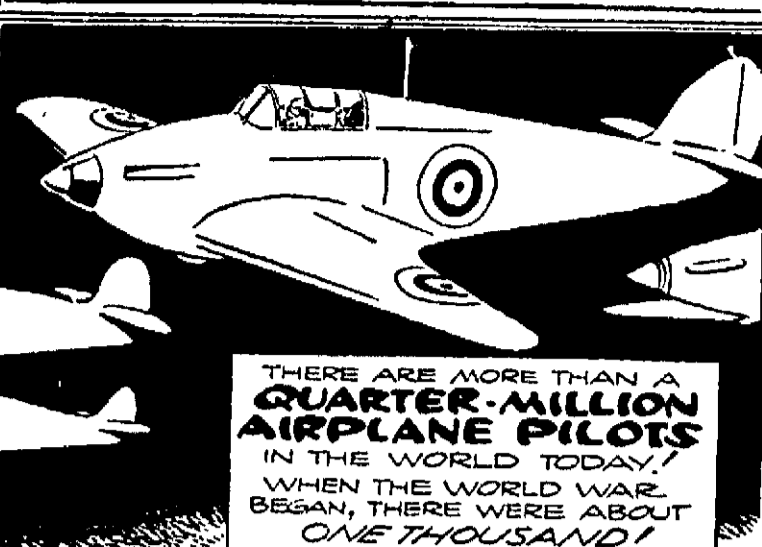
MAN'S place of worship has long been a favorite design for stamps.

There's no religious intolerance in stamps. Practically all faiths are represented.

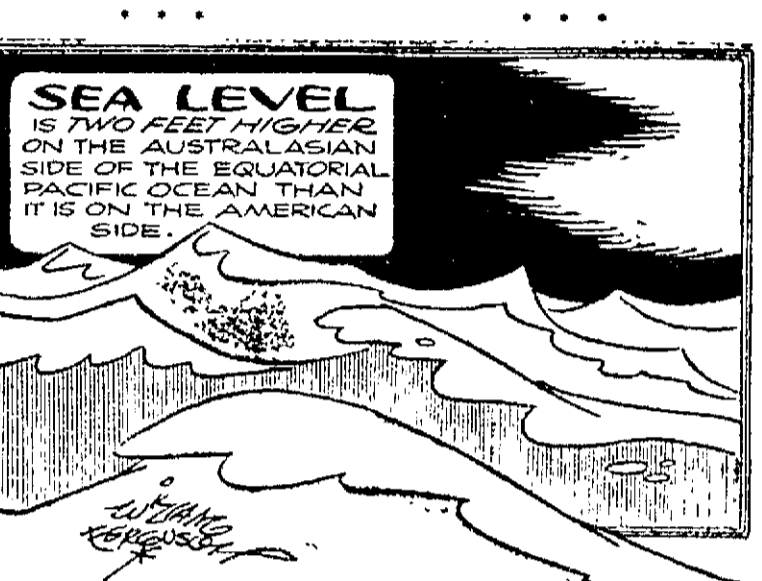
Nicaragua likes its Leon church well enough to put it on nearly 200 values.

United States has no church issues, although the Holy Trinity Church of Wilmington, Del., appeared on a Swedish stamp.

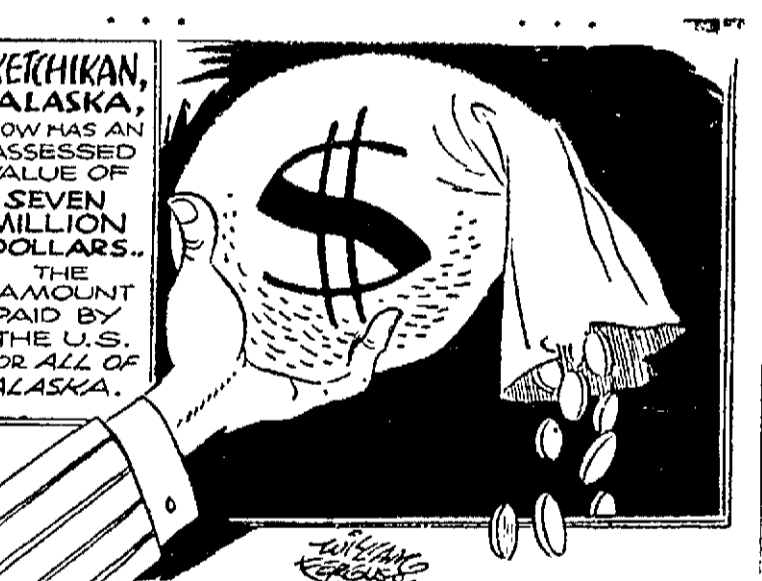

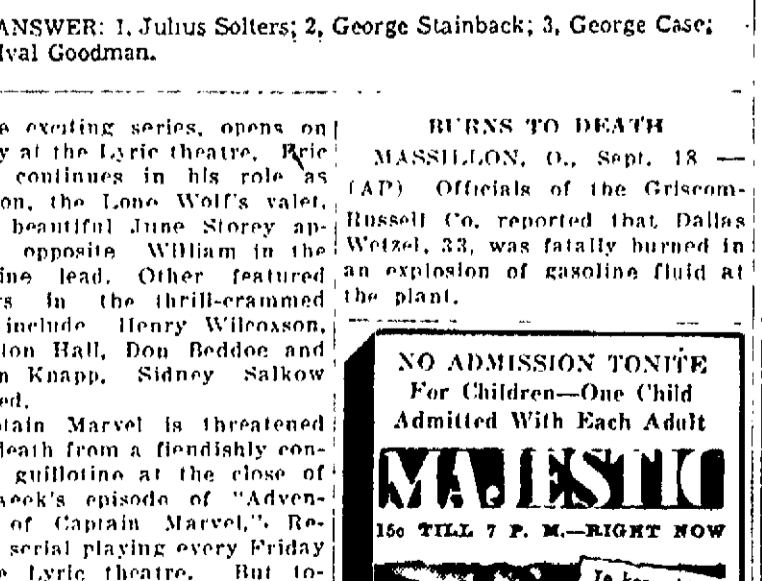
