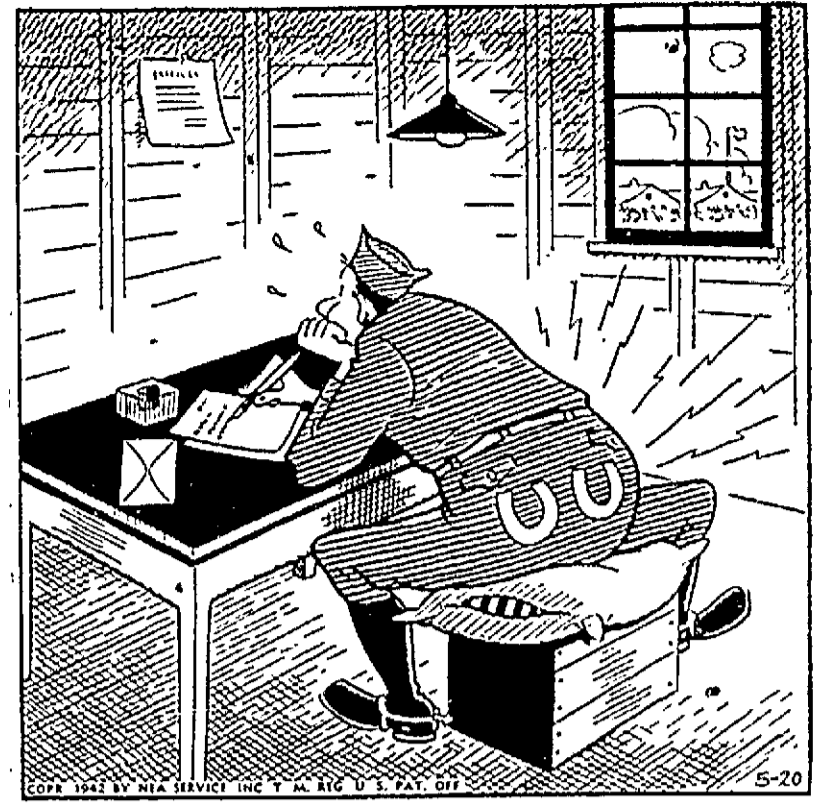

LONE MAN ALIVE AFTER 43 DAYS ON LIFERAFT; TWO COMPANIONS PERISH

GEORGETOWN, British Guiana. — had been burned black by sun and exposure.

Medical examination showed also that he had shell wounds on his left ankle and right temple and a badly bruised cheek and right hip.

That was part of the story told today by Michael Wajda, 28-year-old electric engineer, of New York City, the survivor of three men who climbed onto a life raft after their ship was shelled and torpedoed by an enemy submarine in the Atlantic.

For 46 days, the raft drifted with the winds and currents. Then it was sighted off the Guiana coast. When a rescue boat reached it, Wajda could hardly speak, his sight was impaired and his body had been burned black by sun and exposure.

Their ship sank quickly and the three climbed onto one of its life rafts which was stocked with water and food, including a small supply of concentrated chocolate. After a few days the food grew moldy and spoiled.

They had been drifting 14 days, when Benton became ill. Soon he was unable to swallow. On the 24th day, he died.

To supplement their rations, Bancroft improvised a small net with twine and caught fish. These they ate raw.

A new menace suddenly appeared. The discarded parts of the fish attracted sharks, which trailed the raft night and day.

Bancroft became unable to take food. The 35th day he lost his mind and attempted to jump overboard. Wajda reasoned with him, twice hurled him back on the raft.

But lack of food had made Wajda weak, and Bancroft plunged at last into the sea.
