OTTAWA ADOPTS SLOW TIME TO START OCT. 3

(Lima News Bureau) OTTAWA, Sept. 10 — For the first time since last spring residents of Ottawa will be able to set their watches by the town clock in front of the courthouse after midnight, Sunday, Oct. 3.

The Ottawa council in session here adopted a resolution restoring the community to Eastern Standard or "slow" time at that hour, it was reported Friday by municipal officials.

Announcement also was made of the resignation of Councilman Charles Kerner who explained that he is working in Lima and doesn't have time to take care of municipal duties.

300-TON GUN MOUNTS BUILT IN OHIO PLANT

Delicate Mechanism Can Be Operated By Electric Or Manually

AKRON, O., Sept. 10—(UP)—Three hundred ton gun mounts for some of the world's largest cannon—which can hit "a rowboat over the horizon"—are being made here today by the Wellman Engineering Co. of Cleveland.

Capt. Robb W. James of the War department's Cleveland ordnance district, told a group of newspapermen touring the plant that the company was one of the few in the country producing the giant gun mount.

The mount, a "Barbette carriage," is made for the huge 16-inch coast defense rifles which fire projectiles weighing more than a ton a distance of 28 miles with uncanny accuracy.

"The 16-inch and its Barbette carriage are so delicately balanced that should the regular electric power used to operate the mechanism fail it is possible for only a few men to aim and fire the gun by manual controls alone," Captain James explained.

Aiming the weapon at the precise angle and at the correct elevation to "hit a rowboat over the horizon" is one of modern gunnery's most brilliant feats, he said. When the target is sighted, ranges are carefully worked out mathematically and allowance is made for practically every condition the projectile encounters in flight—wind velocity, direction, and curvature of the earth at the specific point.

gun mount job with past experience in making weapons for Uncle Sam.

Shortly after the Spanish-American war, the plant made the disappearing type mounts for six-inch coast artillery rifles. During the First World war, gun carriages were deserted in favor of sleeping engines and condensers for naval ships. In the 1920's the company built the world's largest pontoon crane for the Navy.

Di. J. C. Hodge, company vice president, said that in most instances the work in the plant did not move from machine to ma-
