WASHINGTON (U.P.) — Pres. Philip Murray of the Congress of Industrial Organizations, announcing plans for the 1943 convention at Philadelphia beginning Nov. 1, declared on Monday the CIO's determination to fight for: ONE. Maintenance of full employment of all workers. TWO. Price control. THREE. Taxation in relation to ability to pay. FOUR. Industrial reconversion (after the war) in the people's interest. FIVE. Social security to share social risks. SIX. A world order based on law and human rights.
