### GEORGIA HUNTS NINE CONVICTS

Life Termers Engineers Break Of Desperadoes

DOUGLAS, Ga., Nov. 8.—(INS) — Nine of 11 desperate convicts who shot and seriously wounded two guards and broke from the state prison camp near Douglas were hunted today thru-out Georgia by posse and blood-hounds.  
Camp officials said the break was engineered by a trusty, Bill Byrd, a life termer in for murder. Byrd walked into the camp office, seized a shotgun and covered guards and visitors while his 10 companions grabbed seven or eight guns and a supply of ammunition kept in the office.  
The guards called on the prisoners to halt, but the reply was two blasts from one of the shotguns. Guard Clarence Cox, 57, was seriously injured by a charge of buckshot in his hip. The other guard, Melvin Clement, 26, was shot in the leg.  
State Police said all but two of the 11 prisoners commandeered a camp truck and drove into Douglas where they split into two groups, one group of six heading east toward Alma and the remainder north. Two were believed to have fled on foot.  
The six were overtaken by a posse when they drove into a dead end road. In the gun battle that followed two of them were recaptured and posse members said they believed they had shot off the hand of another, but he escaped in the woods near Alma with the three others.  
The group that headed north ran out of gas, but held up a preacher and stole his car. Later they held up other passing motorists and last were seen near Jacksonville, about 25 miles from the prison camp. They were believed to have stolen three automobiles in their flight.  
Camp officials said several life termers were among the fugitives.

### FT. LORAMIE GIRL MARRIES WOUNDED MARINE IN WEST

FT. LORAMIE, Oct. 8.—Miss Viola Bollheimer, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Jacob Bollheimer, was married Saturday to S. Sgt. Joseph W. Roland of the Marine Corps, who was awarded the Purple Heart after suffering wounds while serving at Guadalcanal, according to word received by the family. The wedding took place in California, where the bridegroom is stationed at the El Toro air station.  
S. Sgt. Roland, a native of Brooklyn, N. Y., attended the University of Dayton and was employed in that city before entering the service.

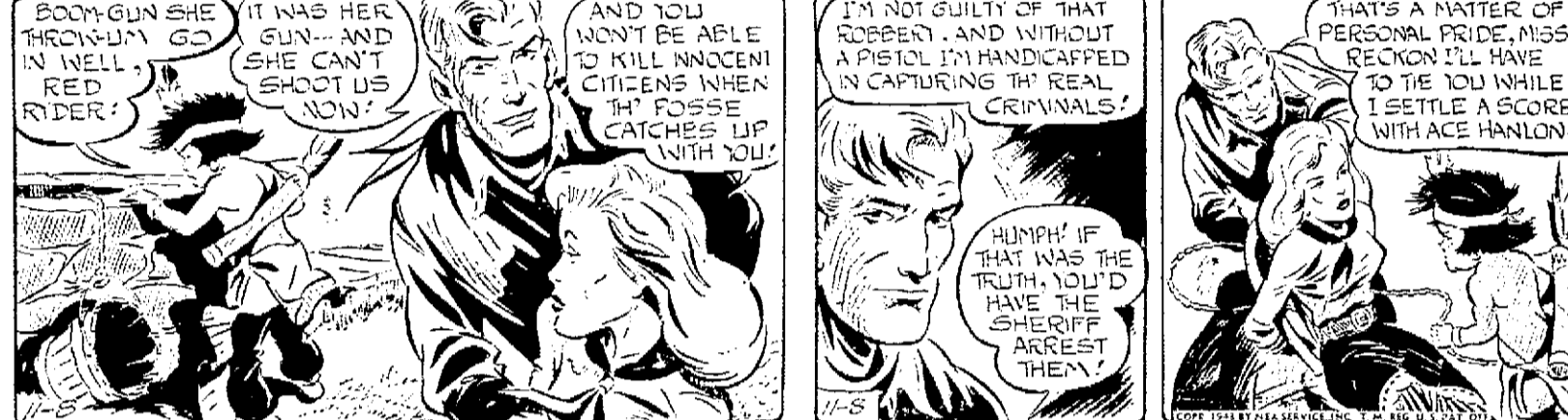

### WARNING IS GIVEN ON USE OF GREEN POINTS

CLEVELAND, Nov. 6.—(AP)—The regional office of Price Administration warned grocers tonight that "blue points" of war ration book two have turned into "green points" for purchases of processed foods with book four.

The stamps X, Y and Z in book two and green stamps A, B and C in book four now are valid for purchase of processed foods, the OPA explained, but some grocers have become confused and are taking blue stamps from book four instead of the green ones.

"George Washington Slept Here," a comedy of a wife who collects antiques and winds up the owner of a ramshackle home, allegorically visited by the first President, will be the "Screen Guild Players" presentation, on Monday, at 9 p. m., over WABC, Carole Landis and Jack Carson star in the adaptation of the hit film.  
The "Voice of Firestone" will offer a musical salute to Armistice Day Monday, WEAF, 7:30 p. m., EST. Numbers include immortal "Stars and Stripes Forever" march. Tenor Richard Crooks sings two popular melodies—"Roses of Picardy" and "When Johnny Comes Marching Home." Howard Barlow and the orchestra conclude the program with a medley of songs from World War I.

### DELPHOS PASTOR HAS APPLIED FOR CHAPLAINCY

DELPHOS, Nov. 8.—Rev. Mark Lewis Andrews, pastor of the Presbyterian church here for the last three and a half years has made application for a chaplaincy in the United States Army, he told his congregation Sunday.  
The minister said that within a short time the preliminaries will be completed preparatory to his physical examination, if his application is accepted. Until he receives word from the government, however, there will be no break in the church's religious program, he announced.  
Rev. Andrews was ordained to the ministry in Delphos, April 28, 1940, and at once became resident pastor. For several weeks prior to that date, however, he filled the pulpit here each Sunday. About two years ago he also became pastor of Gomer Presbyterian church. He is a graduate of Marysville college, Marysville, Tenn, and the Presbyterian Theological seminary, Chicago. He was united in marriage in June 1941 to Miss Gladys E. Glendenning, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. John A. Glendenning, Oak Park, Ill.  
The pastor has two brothers already in service with the Army.
