Looking like nothing less than a circus—with trucks, animal trailers, baggage cars and other paraphernalia—the location company filming "Home in Indiana" roved over three states to bring horses to the screen.

The exciting and romantic film featuring Academy Award-winner Walter Brennan, Lon McAllister, Jeanne Crain, Charlotte Greenwood, June Haver, Ward Bond and Charles Dingle, is scheduled to open Thursday night at the Quilna theatre.

To bring to the screen the picture based on George Agnew Chamberlain's celebrated Saturday Evening Post story, "The Phantom Filly," Hollywood sent its large location troupe of directors, cast, technician experts and Eddie Cronjager, one of the top color cameramen in the industry, to the beautiful and picturesque localities where a trotting horse is practically a member of high society.

After a ten-day stand at Fremont, O., where Director Henry Hathaway filmed the Sandusky-co fair and the colorful half-mile track for a part of the picture, the location company, 134 strong, moved on to the next race held at Marion, O., the home of President Warren G. Harding.

After months of painstaking preparation and research, Alexander Korda has transferred to the screen the thrilling adventure classic, Rudyard Kipling's "Jungle Book," which was filmed in magnificent Technicolor and stars Sabu in the role of Mowgli, a creature that is half-boy and half-wolf.

Korda budgeted his massive technicolor picture of the famous masterpiece at more than a million dollars. Props alone for Kipling's "Jungle Book" cost \$60,000, while items used to embellish the film account of the exploits of the young boy who was raised by jungle wild animals and returned to his native village after 12 years to learn again the ways of man, were valued at \$150,000.
