WASHINGTON, July 1-(IN8) It was believed unlikely in Washington today that the United States would follow its severance of relations with Finland by declaring war on the Finnish re While Great Britain has de

fared was with Finland, such action is not expected in this country Such action would have no practical effect. Also a declaration of war must come from Congress and the egislature is in recess. The fraved thread of American-Fromsh relations was broken when Alexander Thesleff, charge d'affaires for the Finnish legation was summened to the State department and handed his passport


