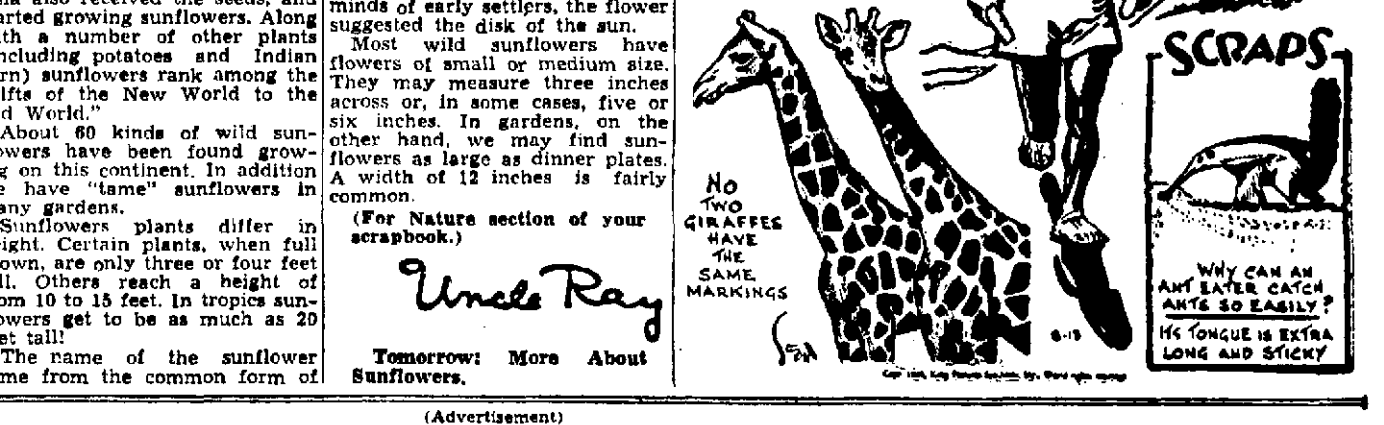
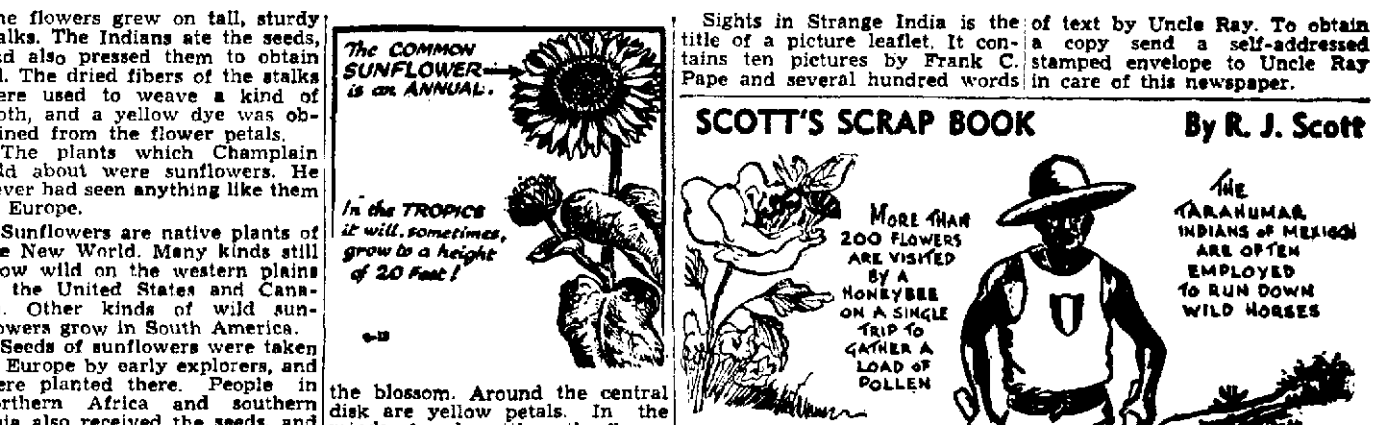
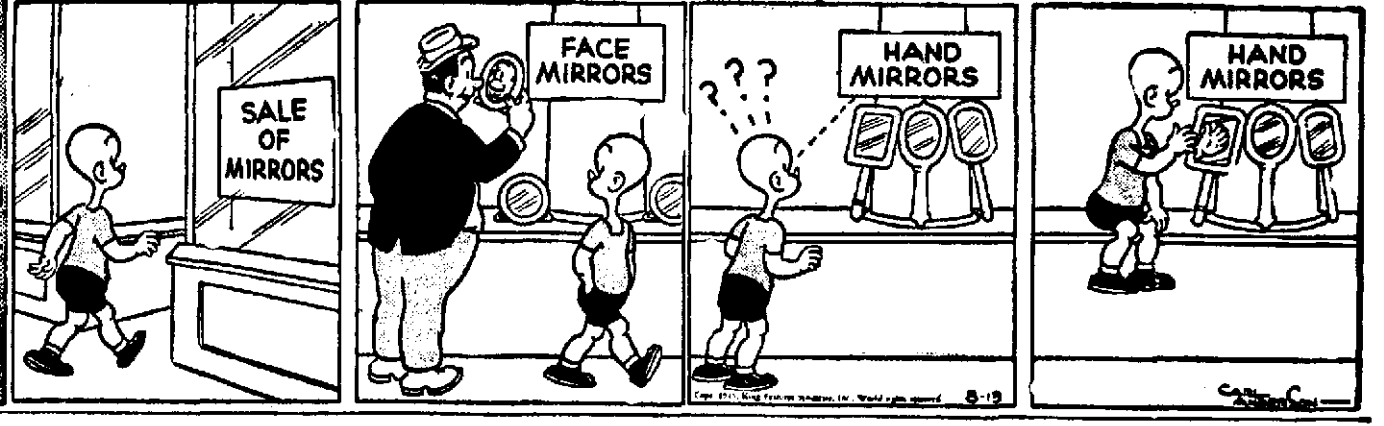
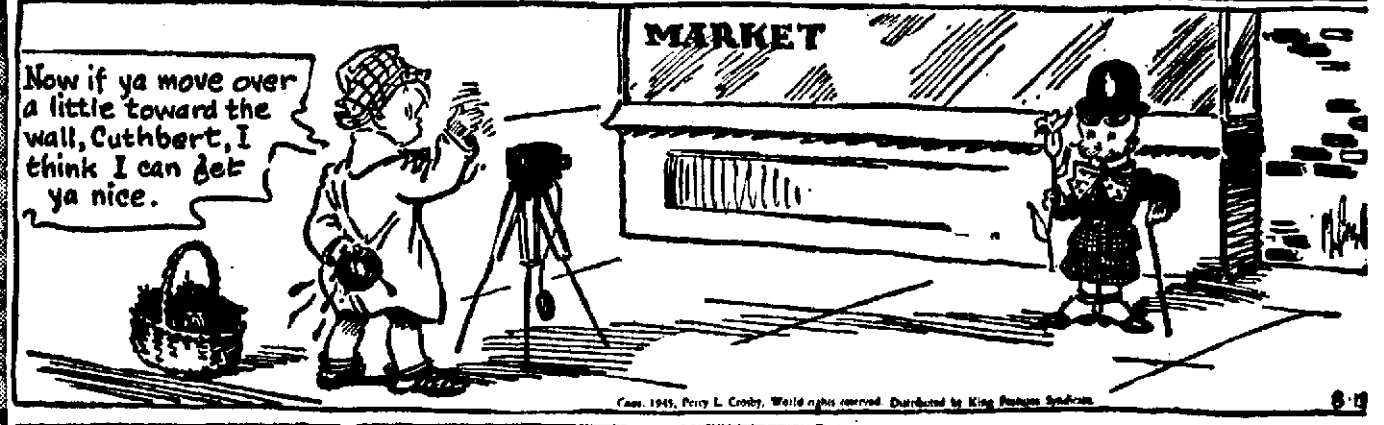
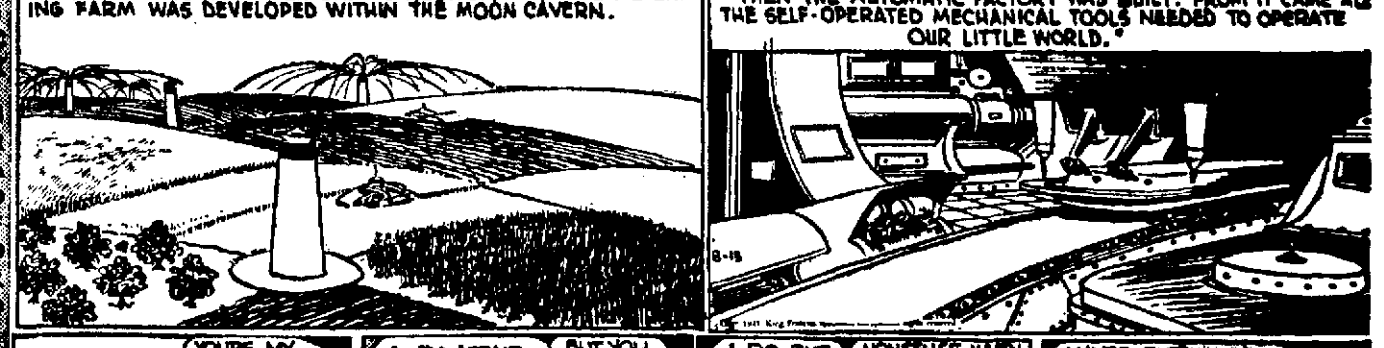
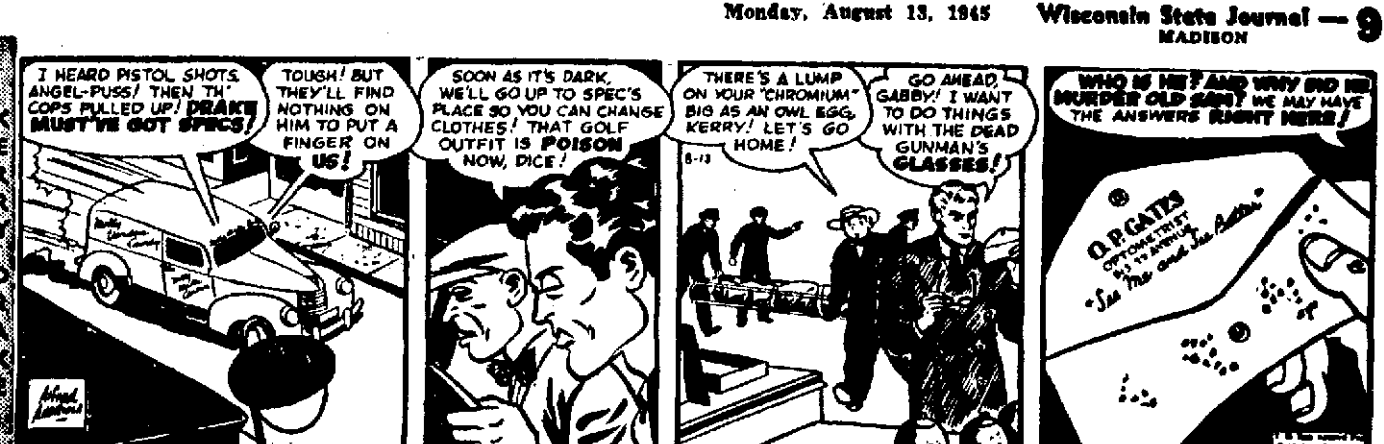
Richland Center Nips Sauk-Prairie
