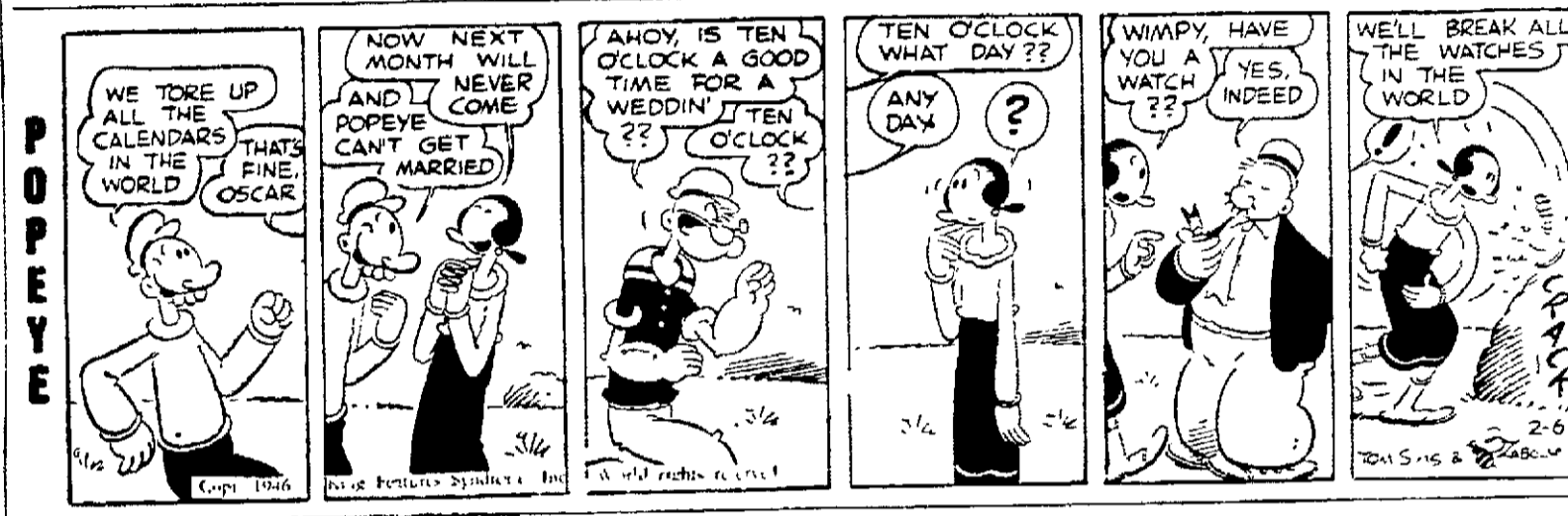
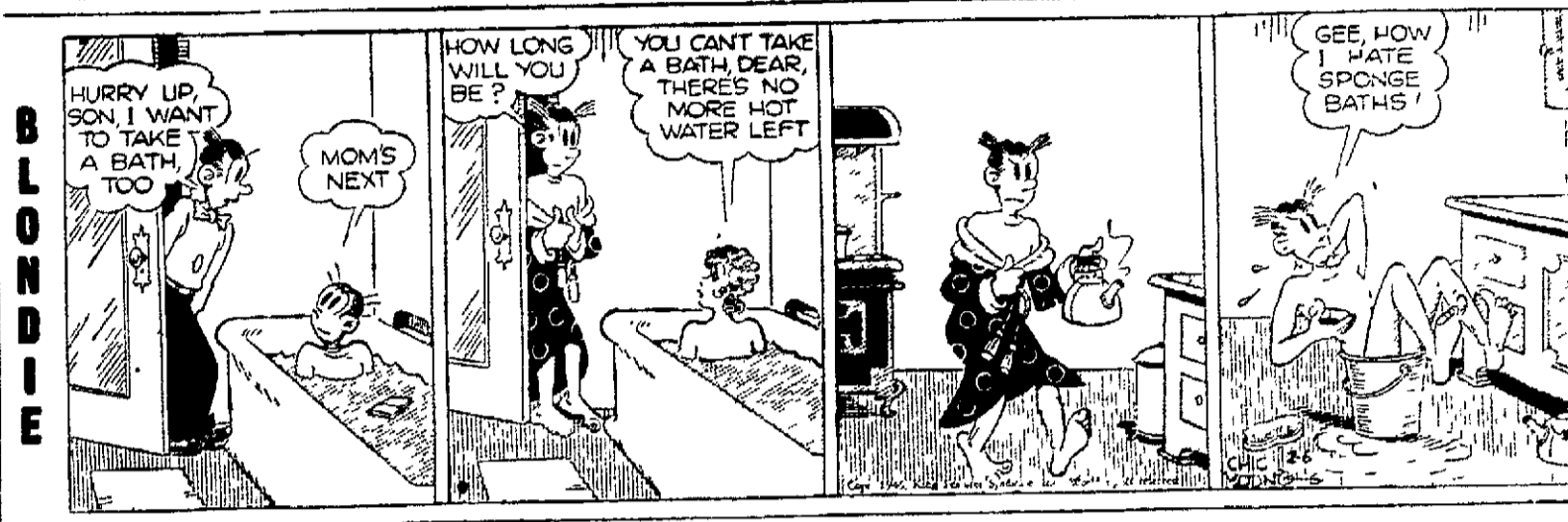

### GAS STATION OPERATORS URGED TO ORGANIZE

YOUNGSTOWN, Feb. 6—(UP)—Andrew J. Rypitch, Cleveland dealer, urged the nation's filling station operators to merge into a single national organization at a meeting here last night.

He spoke before the seventh anniversary audience of the Mahoning Association of Petroleum Retailers.

Rypich said if the aims of most of the branch organizations were achieved, a national integration could be promoted "to the greater advantage of individual filling stations."

Rypich, associated with the sale of automotive parts and gasoline products for the last 19 years, said a national organization also would eliminate the discrimination he said now existed by the large companies, and would bring about recognition of small retailers by government agencies such as the OPA.
