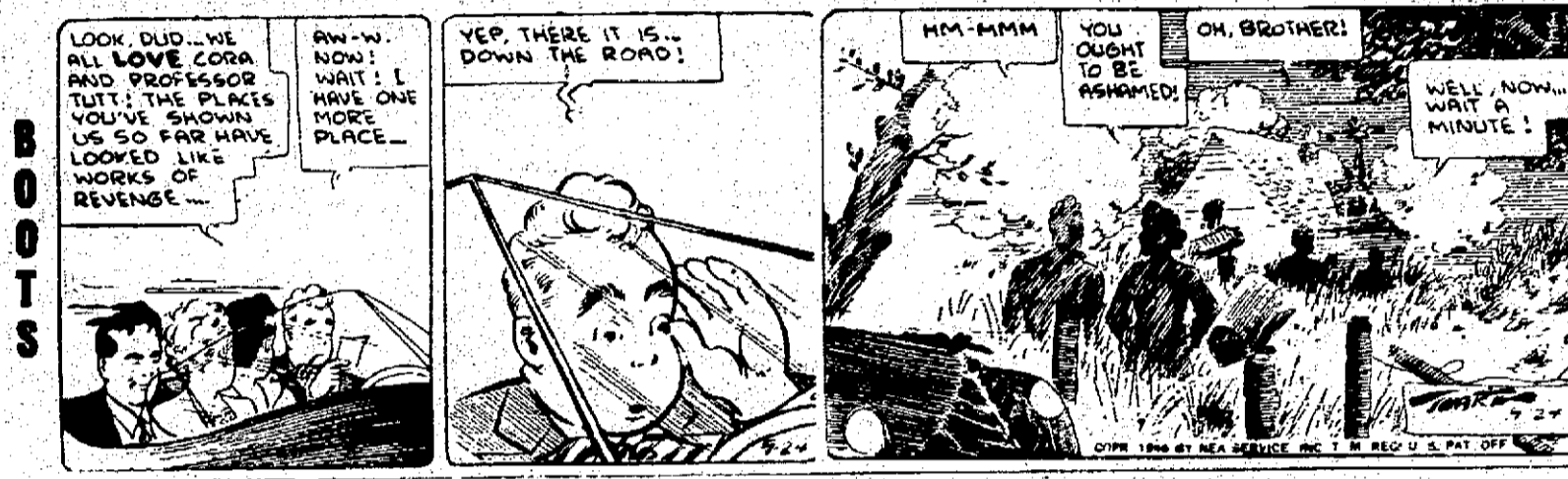

Your GI Rights Questions and Answers On Servicemen's Problems

By DOUGLAS LARSEN WASHINGTON, Sept. 24 (NEA)—The Veterans' Administration has been urged by the states to tighten up requirements on readjustment compensation—the \$20-a-week unemployment pay.

But the 38.5 per cent who, the study showed, had remained on the rolls from 10 to 29 consecutive weeks are, in many cases, abusing the program's purpose by actively avoiding work.

One of the big reasons for men's remaining on the unemployment rolls longer than VA officials believe necessary is the fact that many veterans are holding out for jobs which are better than they can hope to get.
