BALTIMORE — (U.P.) — Mrs. Whitaker Chambers, wife of the former Communist spy courier, was permitted to continue free on \$1,000 bond Saturday, pending a formal hearing on charges of "causing the death" of an elderly woman in an automobile accident.  
Mrs. Chambers, 48, appeared before Magistrate Reuben Caplan who ordered the hearing continued on the charges until the state's attorney set a formal hearing date.  
Her bond of \$1,000 was continued.  
Whittaker Chambers did not accompany his wife to the courtroom. Her attorney was with her.
