Former Milwaukee Sheriff Loses Tax Case

George M. Hanley, Milwaukee county sheriff from 1944 to 1946, must pay additional income tax levies for 1947.

The state board of tax appeals, upholding a ruling of the state department of taxation, said Tuesday that \$84,200 spent by Hanley for advertising expenses did not constitute an allowable expense.

The money was spent, the board said, when Hanley no longer was eligible to succeed himself as sheriff and was a candidate for mayor of Milwaukee.

The former sheriff, asking for an abatement of the assessment, contended that the expense represented an occupation expense and therefore was deductible.

An additional levy of income taxes, arising from sale of automobiles during Hanley's tenure as sheriff, was conceded by him during a hearing and his claim for abatement abandoned.
