As it happened, of course, west had not the slightest pros-fused to play the ace of trumps on pect of winning a heart trick. the first round of that sult was therefore a very deliberate and very simple. He had to play the trumps in such a way as to lose only one trick. He therefore be-gan by leading the deuce of spades from the dummy. East played low, and South put up the

There-fore he got back to durnmy with a club and led another trump. East again played low, and this time South put up the queen of spades, expecting to win the trick. Much to his disgust, however, West played the ace of spades. This made East's jack of spades. high, and the contract was thus defeated.






