RADIO'S SECURITY ROLE IS OUTLINED

WASHINGTON, March 26—(AP) The roll which the government wants commercial radio and television broadcasters to fill in the event of air attack on the United States was outlined here today. Claimed as highly restricted information, it was detailed behind closed doors to a gathering of more than 1,000 persons, representing the 3,248 station operators across the country. Those present were placed 'on honor' to keep the plan confidential. The session was arranged at the request of the Air Defense Command, which along with the Office of Civilian Defense sent top officials to the gathering. The session followed a number of public statements by FCC Chairman Wayne Coy that the government has no intention of 'taking over' the privately owned broadcasting stations in the event of a major war. It also came in the wake of wide demands by civilian defense officials for radio service, for communication with the general public in times of emergency. The FCC held today's king-size private conference in Interdepartmental Auditorium, the big assembly hall where the Atlantic Pact was signed. The admissions were carefully screened. U. S. press and radio news reporters were admitted under the same restrictions applying to all present.
