Ronald Colman Writes Script for 'Ivy' Show

HOLLYWOOD. For the second time since the beginning of the award-winning (Peabody Award, 1951), "Halls of Ivy" radio show, which stars Mr. and Mrs. Ronald Colman, the star himself has come up with scripts for the program. Colman's original this time revolves around the Halloween spirit, with reminiscing of early childhood gags and tricks. Franks played by English children during the Colman era will be a featured high light.

Although the script has actually been penned by Colman, it will be doctored by the show's chief scribe, Don Quinn, originator of the series. This is necessary, so as to maintain the famous Quinn style of presentation which has given "Ivy" such a highly rated reputation.

The special Colman edition of "Halls of Ivy" will be presented over KFI and the National Broadcasting Co. network Wednesday evening, Nov. 7, at 8:30.

The first rough draft of a New York stage adaptation of the "Ivy" series has been recently completed with present plans to put the play onto Broadway early next year. At this writing it is not known whether Ronald and Benita will do the starring roles in the stage version.
