As a fitting thibuie in the late James $A$. Heme, famous Nine. teenth Century dramatisi, on the oceasion of the 100 h annuverary of his birth, the National Droadcasting Co. has sclected his "The Minute Men of 1774 " as the first mroducion in its elaborate series of America's Lost Plays which will be presented over WEAF Thursdave fiom 8 to $9 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{m}$.

The playwright is the father of Julie and Chrystal Herne, both of whom are famous in the contemporary theatre. He is best remembered for "Shose Acres" and "Sag Harbor," which were laid in his beloved New England. "The Minute Men," another of his most popular works was, until zecently, believed urrevocably lost. It has just been unearthed after four years of reseanch work by Barrett if. Ciark, evecuive dinector of the Jramatists' llay Service, who woiked in conperation with the Authors' League of Amelica and the Dramatists' Guild and with the fmancia! assustance of the Rockefeller Foundation. It whll he minted for the fist time with other unpublished plass by Ileme in a 20 -volume cdition of Amesica's Lout Plays sonn to he icsued by the Princeton Vmversity Precs.
"The Mmute Men" was fust proluced on Apuil 6. 1886, at the Walnut Street theatre in Philadelphia with Herne in the leading role. Subutled "An Ongmal Mihtaiy Comedy-Drama." it is really a molodiama in the oricinal sense of the torm, that 1 s , a drama with incidental melodies.
