Clark, executive director of the Dramatists' Play Service, who Dramatists' Play Service, who worked in cooperation with the Authors' League of America and the Dramatists' Guild and with the financial assistance of the the Dramatists' Guild and with the financial assistance of the Rockefeller Foundation. It will be printed for the first time with other unpublished plays by Herne in a 20-volume edition of Ameri-ca's Lost Plays soon to be issued by the Princeton University Press. "The Minute Men" was first produced on April 6, 1886 at the

produced on April 6, 1886, at the Walnut Street theatre in Philadelphia with Herne in the leading role. Subtitled "An Original Mili-tary Comedy-Drama." it is really a melodiama in the original sense of the term, that is, a drama with incidental melodies.
