

# Young Quartet To Guest On Uncle Ezra Show Saturday

Iowa Singers Added To Staff Of Chicago's WLS Will Be Heard On Program At 9 P. M.

The Williams Brothers Quartet, who will guest on the Uncle Ezra show Saturday night, 9 p. m., WEAJ have been in show business six years . . . though the youngest, Andy, is only 12 years old.

Bob (who is now 21) and Don (17) were soloists in the choir back in Wall Lake, Iowa, when they decided to commercialize on their voices. Duos were not much in demand, so they dragged along their younger brothers, Dick and

Andy, and called themselves a close-harmony quartet. They have been featured on WCLO (Des Moines) for several years, and last week were added to the regular staff of WLS, Chicago.

Madeline Gray's "Bright Idea Club" is one of the few programs asked to represent NBC during a special broadcast by the chain from the World's Fair, which is "Radio Day." Thus, within a few weeks, the "Bright Idea Club" returns to the exposition grounds where it had its own day including a Saturday broadcast, a parade and a gathering of most of the youngsters who have ever appeared on the series.

One of the most elaborate programs ever presented at either exposition, marking Broadcasting Day at the World's Fair of 1940 in New York and the Golden Gate International Exposition in San Francisco on Saturday, will be broadcast over the coast-to-coast combined networks from 7 to 8 p. m. Scores of famous stars will appear in person at the expositions to take part in a gigantic tribute to the radio industry.
